Format & Important Information

Format:

- All tournaments are single elimination.
- Limited rebuys available.
- Sunday Tournament is a free entry tournament with a \$20 side pool + trophy.

Points:

- Open - 7/9/9/9/11 points.
- Masters - 11/11/13/15 points, clocks at 2 minutes per point, 12 second delay.
- Speedgammon - 7pt matches, clocks at 3 minutes total with 10 second delay.
- Sunday Tournament – 5pt matches, 7pt final.

All entry fees to be paid in cash on the day unless paid prior.

Winners should register their result by providing the desk with a scoresheet signed by the loser.

All matches to be played in the tournament room.

Inform the desk if you are leaving the playing area for any length of time whilst active in a tournament.

Boards may not be removed from the playing area.

Scheduling conflicts to be reported to the desk for resolution.

All tournament matches will be entered into the ABF ratings system.

Precision dice must be used if available.

Clocks are mandatory in Speedgammon and Masters tournaments, optional in other tournaments.

TDs reserve the right to put slow matches on clocks.

Please keep food and drink away from boards!

Please practise safe hygiene, wash your hands or sanitise before and after every match!
